Financial Policy Information

Payment of Fees

All fees are due and payable at the time of services unless alternate arrangements are made in advance. The fee for treatments with Dr. Nealon ranges from \$85-\$425 (see bottom of document for breakdown of fees). The initial session is approximately 50 minutes with a fee of \$240. Follow-up visits are 20-25 minutes in length and fees are based on the type of treatment. Any treatment going over the scheduled time will be billed in 15 minute increments at the rate of \$50. **Please note:** Dr. Nealon may provide different services and length sessions could vary. Rates will reflect this.

Payment

Payment is due at the time of service. Cash and checks are preferred, but credit cards and HSA's are accepted for payment. Payment will be processed at time of service unless other arrangements are made. Payments that are not received within 30 days of the statement due date will accrue a \$10 late charge every billing cycle the payment is not received. If payment is not received after 120 days, account balances may be sent to a collection agency. Any accounts paid by checks that are returned for non-sufficient funds will be charged an additional \$40 fee.

Insurance

La Luna Natural Health does not accept any insurance plans and is considered out of network. You may request that La Luna Health provide you with a superbill so that you can submit to your insurance company, but this does not guarantee that your insurance company will reimburse you at any amount. It is recommended that you contact your insurance company for accurate information.

MVA

If you are using PIP or another form of insurance from a motor vehicle accident, there is a possibility that treatment will not be covered. If for any reason that your insurance does not cover treatments provided, you will be responsible for costs of appointments.

Late Cancellation/No Show Policy

As courtesy to other patients, a specific amount of time has been set aside for your treatment. Arriving late means that your treatment will be adjusted to fit into the time schedule or rescheduled. A 24-hour notice of intent to cancel or reschedule appointments is required, except in case of emergencies. No shows and late cancellations will be subject to a fee (listed below).



No-show and Late Cancellation policy is as follows:

Initial clinic visits will be charged a cancellation fee of \$100 and follow up care has a cancellation fee of \$50.
